

JUNIOR HIGH SUPPLY LIST (2017-2018)

It is expected that all students keep these supplies on hand **FOR THE ENTIRE SCHOOL YEAR**. **Being properly prepared is essential to the success of every student and it avoids disruptions in class.** We do use all of these. I also have some additional personal supplies that I will provide for students.



1. A binder with two-inch rings.
2. Two 1-inch plain binders for Geography.
3. A sturdy plastic portfolio for papers coming to school and going home each day.
4. White out liquid or strips (white out is our friend.)
5. A set of **at least 24** colored pencils (not erasable.)
6. **Six** sharpened standard #2 pencils or mechanical pencils (0.9 lead highly recommended.)
7. At least two regular **blue** or **black** ball point or roller ball pens and at least one juicy **red** one.
8. A large eraser (white preferred) and pencil top or slide up erasers.
9. A good sharp pair of adult-sized scissors (not children's.)
10. A set of non-permanent colored markers, not the thick ones, 20-50 colors.
11. A highlighter.
12. Black Sharpies: regular & ultra-fine point.
13. A sharp-bladed hand-held pencil sharpener with catch-all, regular or battery powered.
14. An **AMPLE** supply of **college ruled** white binder paper.
15. Two glue sticks and a big bottle of Tacky Glue.
16. A calculator with **large** buttons (**10 or 12 digit**, square root function, **no scientific calculators, no small buttons, no fractions capability**.)
17. A **STURDY** plastic shoebox to use as a pencil/supplies box.
18. A 12-inch ruler with English and metric measures and an optional 6-inch ruler.
19. A ream of white copier paper for class use.
20. Ten dividers for binder, **WITHOUT POCKETS**.
21. A sturdy backpack, no insignias or characters, etc.
22. A plain bag or tote for PE clothes and shoes.
23. Four book covers (paper bags, butcher paper, cloth, **no sticky stuff**).
24. **Many, many** tablets of graph paper with **FOUR, not five** squares per inch.
25. A hand-held hole punch.
26. A sturdy compass for drawing circles,
27. A clear plastic protractor (thinner is better, no thick ones).
28. Two boxes of Kleenex and two rolls of paper towels for classroom use (we use a lot).
29. An 8x10 inch or larger personal whiteboard and two juicy dry erase pens and an eraser.
30. A locker shelf or two.
31. A net for catching bugs.
32. Other supplies will be required for class projects. I will let you know.
33. A GREAT ATTITUDE (required for your survival)!!!

Please make certain you label EVERY SINGLE THING in permanent ink!!!

Please remember backpacks, book satchels, book covers, and lunch boxes may have small brand name logos such as Jansport or Nike. **They may have shapes or simple designs** on them such as plain flowers, hearts, dots, geometric shapes or camouflage. They may **NOT** have symbols, characters, sport teams, insignias, or emblems. **Folders and binders must be plain, solid colors.** They cannot have any designs, pictures, logos, or other decorations on them.
